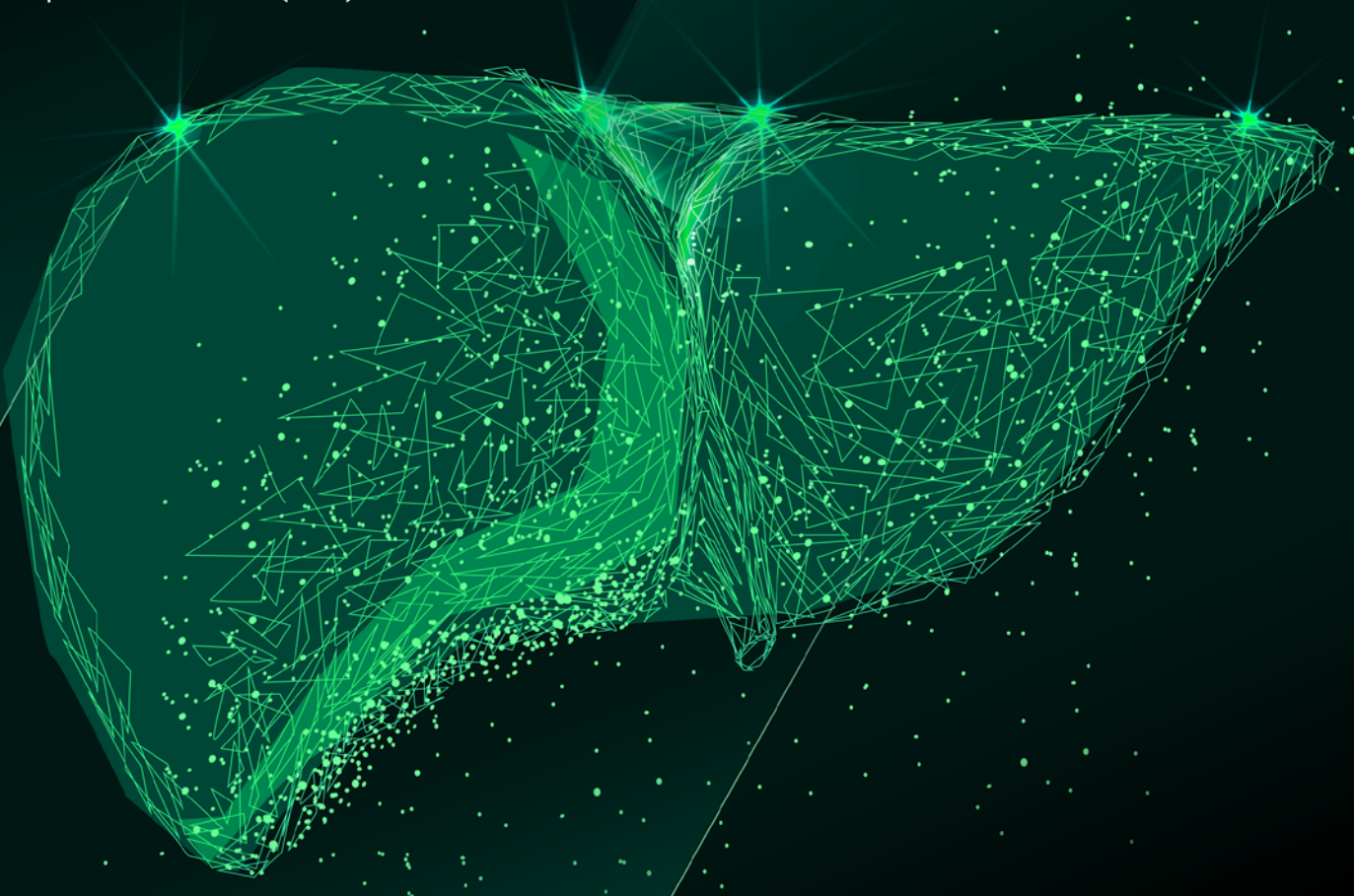

## COURSE OVERVIEW

Advances in Hepatobiliary Diseases 2024: Update XXIV will present an update on the diagnosis and management of hepatobiliary diseases. World renown experts will present a broad range of topics. Didactic presentations will be augmented with panel discussions, instructive case presentations supplemented by questions and answers and panel discussions.
